### **TOUR FAREWELL and TRACK CELEBRATION WELCOME and REGISTRATION**

- Friday evening in the Conference Centre as a Farewell for any Tourers leaving us and Welcome and Registration to the Track Celebrators. Cash bar will be open and a meal available continually from early evening.

### **TRACK CELEBRATION**

- Saturday cash café open mid morning to mid afternoon in Conference Centre.
- Driver Training – never driven your Alfa Romeo on a race track, want to have a go? Be shown how by experienced race drivers with you in your own car. You will need at least cotton overalls taped at ankles and wrists and an approved helmet. If you register early enough we *may* be able to supply race suits/overalls and helmets. For track novices only.
- Sprints Single Car – put your new found track skills to use by single sprinting. To single car sprint you will need, besides your AROC membership card, a Motorsport NZ day licence available on the day from the Motorsport NZ Steward.
- Sprints Dual Car – for holders of Motorsport NZ Clubsport Licence and National Race Licences and above. These licences are only available through motorsport NZ at [www.motorsport.org.nz](http://www.motorsport.org.nz) and/or contact AROC's Motorsport NZ rep. - Racing – Alfa Romeo only grids. Four races at intervals throughout the day. Motorsport NZ National Race Licence required.
- Skid pan – test your driving skills in full view of the supportive AROC audience that will be lounging around the Conference Centre. Note skid pan may not be operational in which case Track programme may be adjusted.
- Concours/Show and Shine – proud of it? Show it, no matter its condition, you might win a prize, for nerve if nothing else.
- New car tests – you might buy one. Keep Andrew racing.
- Parade laps and hot laps – a chance for everyone to circulate New Zealand's newest race track in a controlled manner.
- Club shop – open all day next to the café. Everything not size specific will be available.

## **AROCNZ Inc. ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING**

### **Registration Fees:**

- If you are coming for everything except to compete in Sprints and Racing your total fee for the weekend is \$80 per person. This one fee entitles you to attend the functions and partake of the meals on Friday and Saturday evenings and Sunday morning. It entitles you to take part in all of the Saturday Track Celebration events except Sprints and Races.
- If you are Sprinting, single or dual car, your total fee for the weekend is \$110 per person. This one fee entitles you to all of the above plus entry to Sprints.
- If you are Sprinting and Racing or Racing only your total fee for the weekend is \$150 per person. This one fee entitles you to all of the above plus entry to Races.
- None of the three fee levels include beverages from the bar, breakfast (available for \$12.50 per person room service), food from the café or accommodation.
- The fees are set and fixed no matter how many or few of the events on any of the three days you take part in.

### **Accommodation:**

- Hampton Downs 2 bedroom on site apartments available for \$180 per apartment per night. All apartments have good views of the track and infield, easy walking (and vehicle) access to the Conference Centre, are well appointed with bathroom, kitchen etc, can sleep at least four in two bedrooms.
